The 2018 "Toolkit for Girls" workshop will provide up to 30 interested females in Years 10, 11 and 12 students from the Mackay Region with an insight into the life of a tradesperson first hand.

During the one day workshop, held at the Mackay Engineering College (MEC) the students will listen to a wide range of female industry apprentices and trades people to understand more about their roles and what it is they do.

Students will also have the opportunity to undertake practical activities in the "Hands On" component at the MEC workshop. CQUniversity, Mackay campus once again has come on board with an additional segment involving some activities in the CQU Engineering department with robotics. From this workshop there will be an opportunity for students to participate in other activities such as the Try a Trades site visit at Hail Creek Mine, and also visit other work sites as the Cummins workshop in Mackay.
