


Heard your mates talking about the

Mackay Engineering College partners with prominent local businesses to give you an insight into what it's like to be an apprentice or tradesperson.

The Checklist

- Are you in Year 10?
- Do you attend Mackay North SHS, Sarina SHS, Mackay SHS, Pioneer SHS, Mirani SHS or Mackay Northern Beaches SHS?
- Are you interested in experiencing different trade experiences associated with the Manufacturing, Engineering, Automotive or Electrical Industries?



If you ticked all 3 boxes, you should consider applying for the Try Trades program with the Mackay Engineering College. The program runs for 5 days over five weeks of Term 3 each year. During this time you will attend the MEC one day each week and take part in the following experiences:

- ◆ Field trips and industry tours
- ◆ Mentoring by tradespeople in their workplace
- ◆ Complete welding and electrical projects at the MEC
- ◆ Tour Rio Tinto Hail Creek Mine
- ◆ Tour BMA Hay Point Coal Terminal
- ◆ Tour Dalrymple Bay Coal Terminal



How much does it cost? Successful students will be required to pay a materials and administrative cost of \$80. This cost covers transportation, catering, mine site and coal terminal tours, other administrative overheads and the provision of a Mackay Engineering College PPE work shirt.

How do I apply?

You need collect an application package from Mrs Esau in E6 or your ITD teacher. Once completed, return it to Mrs Esau in E6 by Friday 1 June and it will be forwarded to the Mackay Engineering College for consideration. Only 10 students from each school can take part so make sure that you submit quality responses in your application and return it as soon as possible. Successful applicants will be notified by the end of June.
