

Senior school students in **Grades 9 to 12** in Mackay are invited to enter the Whitsunday Voices Youth Literature Festival's Slam Poetry Competition.

Teams will be coached by highly acclaimed and award winning Slam Poet, Emilie Zoey Baker.

Teams can include 2, 3 or 4 members.

Depending on entries received, we may have two categories: Grades 9 and 10 students in one category, and Grades 11 and 12 students in another.

Teams are required to participate in a workshop hosted by Emilie where she will present what is involved in writing and performing slam poetry, and then teams will break away into groups to work on their own poem. Emilie will work with each team to refine their poetry, and by the end of the workshop, teams should have a poem that can be refined as they practice for the competition.

Schools should support their teams and allow time for them to practice on 18 and 19 July.

If a school has more than one team participating in a category, they may need to run their own heats to select the team to compete at the Festival.


