What is physical abuse?

Passive Violence

Passive forms of school violence include verbal bullying, making threats, intimidating, ostracising, and electronic aggression (cyber-bullying).

Physical Violence

Physical forms of school violence include various types of fighting (punching, kicking, biting, slapping), and can involve assault with a weapon or involvement with a gang.
